- You may be responsible for replacing the yearbook.
- Your student may have to give up his/her yearbook until the defaced yearbook is replaced.

- June 4th Chromebook Return: During 2nd period, all 8th graders will be returning their Chromebook and charger to the library. Students will NOT have a school issued Chromebook during the summer.

Finish Strong

Our 8th grade students are excited and looking forward to the end of year celebrations, but it is important for them to remember that they have several weeks of course work remaining and they need to finish strong! Students must complete all class requirements and handle celebration activities in a mature and responsible way. Please remember that any poor choices in behavior could preclude a student from participation in 8th grade activities and/or promotion. Our goal is for our students to be successful in their classroom, enjoy all planned school activities, and conduct themselves as responsible students.

Promotion Dress Code: Keeping in mind that Promotion is the capstone activity to three years of hard work, we ask that students please dress accordingly. Cell Phones: Students are not permitted to have cell phones during the promotion ceremony. Students will need to leave cell phones with their parent/quardians.

Seating: You are welcome to bring lawn chairs since seating is limited. Pop-up tents and umbrellas are not permitted. Please be mindful and respectful of others as you find space around the quad area to observe the ceremony. Please note the inclined grass areas in the main quad area will be for blanket seating only, no chairs or standing are allowed in this area.

Tickets: Students will be provided a total of four tickets to promotion as we have very limited space on our facility. Please be respectful of this request.

Photography: GradImages will photograph each 8th grade student as they receive their promotion certificate. Therefore, please do not go near the promotion stage during the ceremony, as your desire to get a close-up photo can cause a disruption. GradImages will mail a complimentary proof. Parking: Limited parking will be available in the main Oak Valley parking lot. Guests may need to walk from streets in the surrounding neighborhood. Carpooling and/or using a car ride service is strongly encouraged. Please be mindful of parking rules in the neighboring community. Limousines are not appropriate for this event and cannot park in the OVMS parking lot. The bus loop will be reserved for staff parking only.

Audience Conduct Expectations: In order to allow each promoter and his/her family to fully enjoy their moment of honor, activities that could detract from the ceremony are strongly discouraged. Balloons, noisemakers, cow bells, air horns, vuvuzelas and other such items will not be permitted on campus. These items obstruct the view for others and prevent families hearing the program. Guests bringing them in will be asked to discard them or return them to their vehicles.
