What is the difference between registration and enrollment?

- **Enrollment** takes place when a student is new to the school district, or is returning after having moved out of PUSD.
- **Registration** is a different 2-part process that takes place every year **online & in-person** the week before school starts. Most OVMS families completed the online portion in spring.

How can I pay for everything?

You may write a separate check for each category of items you purchase or you may use a credit card with a nominal fee.

How do I pay for PE Clothes & Camp?

You may pay with a cash, check, credit card(with nominal fee) or online at your convenience.

Do we have to attend during our designated hour?

We have almost 500 students attending registration. To minimize traffic, parking concerns and long lines, we ask that you come during the time slot you were assigned based on last name, listed in the gray section to the right. Additionally, there is construction on our parking lot which limits the amount of space available.

We are out of town during our assigned registration day, what do we do?

Your student will be able to collect their Chromebook during the first day of school. School photos will be taken during the first few days of PE, as well.

- **Part Two:** Come to Oak Valley for August registration; students will:
 - ◇ Have their yearbook/ID photo taken (ID cards will be distributed first week of school) - Gym
 - ◇ Purchase PE clothes/Option to pay for 6th Grade Camp - MPR
 - ◇ Pick up their new Chromebook - Library

PE CLOTHES

Students who wish to purchase PE clothes may do so online or with cash or check at registration. If you wish to purchase online, please use this link: [OVMS Webstore](#). (Please follow directions on the left side of page to purchase online). You must bring a **copy of your receipt** with you to the first day of PE to pick up the items. Shorts and shirts are \$15.00 each and a new lock is \$5.00. Returning students who still have their PE clothes do not need to purchase new items.

YEARBOOKS

Yearbooks are available to purchase [online](#) only, beginning July 15th. The price starts \$50.00 and will increase as the school year progresses.

FAQ's

My 6th grader is out of town; do they need to attend registration & orientation?

Students are encouraged to attend; pictures are taken for the yearbook and they will receive their new Chromebook.

Can I send my child with a neighbor or friend?

Yes, provided parent/legal guardian has completed the online portion of registration, and student has any paperwork that still needs to be submitted.

When will my student receive their Chromebook?

At registration, 6th graders and new students to Oak Valley will receive their new Chromebook that they will keep while they are at our school.

Can I put money in my child's lunch account at registration?

We will not be able to accept cash or checks for lunch at registration. There is a drop box in the main office that will be available on the first day of school. You may add funds to your child's account online at [MySchoolBucks](#).

I have children in multiple grades; do all of them need to attend registration?

No, in-person registration is only for 6th graders and students new to Oak Valley. If you have a returning 7th or 8th grader they do not need to come to registration. They will have their photo taken during the first few days of PE and will receive any textbooks during class.

Our ASB students will be on campus selling their ASB discount cards for \$80.
